Established in 1979, Forest Pulse is a registered charity organisation based in the heart of the Forest of Dean.

We offer inclusive activities to disabled children and young people aged 4-25 living or attending school/ college in the Forest of Dean and support for their families. Originally set up by a group of parents of children with disabilities, our charity is run by a group of Trustees who are mostly parent members. Fundamental to our development and expansion is Pam Jones, our charity's manager for almost 30 years. Her huge contribution to Forest Pulse and to disabled children and their families in the Forest of Dean was recognised in 2018 with the award of a British Empire Medal. We want to build on the firm foundation we have created for Forest Pulse so that we can continue to offer a wide and varied range of activities, offering opportunities to build knowledge and experience, whilst providing the right help and support for our young members.

As well as the team of dedicated and highly trained individuals that work at Forest Pulse, we also rely on a large number of volunteers per year, from in and around the local community, who help and support our children and young people. The support we offer extends to families too which in turn means the whole family becomes part of the Forest Pulse community. Many parents, carers and family members volunteer in order to give something back. This really gives the charity a family feel.

## **OUR FUTURE**

We want to continue to make a positive impact on the community in which we work and have some ambitious plans to grow and develop the charity in the coming years. We offer so much already, but we could do more. We want to expand our offering and our capabilities and in order to do this, we are looking for local businesses who are willing to make Forest Pulse their charity of choice for future fundraising events. As we are such a community focussed organisation, we are reaching out to our wider community to ask for help. Outside of the Summer months when costs are higher, it costs £12,000 per month to run Forest Pulse and we are always looking for new funding to cover this.

## Some examples of our costs are:

- £20 provides a two hour specialist music and sensory session
- £30 pays for a child to attend a three hour after school play session
- £300 pays for a child to attend a four week summer activity club.
- £355 pays for a young person to attend our weekly youth club for a year.
- £875 enables a child to attend a weekly after school activity for a year.
- £600 covers the cost of a child attending a fortnightly weekend club for a year
- £2,000 pays for a Personal Assistant for a year, giving parents/carers four hours of respite a week.
- £2,350 pays for a music therapist for three hours a week (31 weeks).

- £4,500 runs a weekly social group for young adults for
- £5,000 covers the annual cost of hiring a local soft play centre where our younger members can socialise whilst keeping physically active.
- £9,000 pays our rent for a
- £30,000 pays for our Activity Manager to organise and lead all our exciting activities.
- £40,000 runs our four week **Summer Activity Programme** for over 100 children/young
